pursuant to the regulation on waste electrical equipment

The design, materials used and care applied in manufacturing as well as excellent servicing make all *RIEGL* products suited for long life. When *RIEGL* products finally reach the end of their life-cycle we take back waste electrical equipment free of charge in compliance with the provision on waste electrical equipment and dispose of it properly in our production plant at Horn.

The *Elektroaltgeräteverordnung* (provision on waste electrical equipment; EAG-VO, Federal Law Gazette II No. 121/2005) transposes the following EU Directives into Austrian law:

- Directive 2002/96/EC on waste electrical and electronic equipment (WEEE), Official Journal L 37 of 13/2/2003 p.24, as amended by Directive 2003/108/EC amending Directive 2002/96/EC on waste electrical and electronic equipment, Official Journal No. L 345 of 31/12/2003 p. 106;

and

- Directive 2002/95/EC on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (RoHS), Official Journal No. L37 of 13/2/2003 p. 19.
